THE ALEX FITCH ROOM

The Alex Fitch Room is the most poignant room at Harrow School. Located in the War Memorial Building, the entire contents of the room were donated by the Fitch family in memory of their son, who died in the First World War. His portrait is hung above the fireplace and the light above it is never put out in respect for the fallen. All proceeds from the hire of this room go towards a bursary for a boy to attend Harrow.

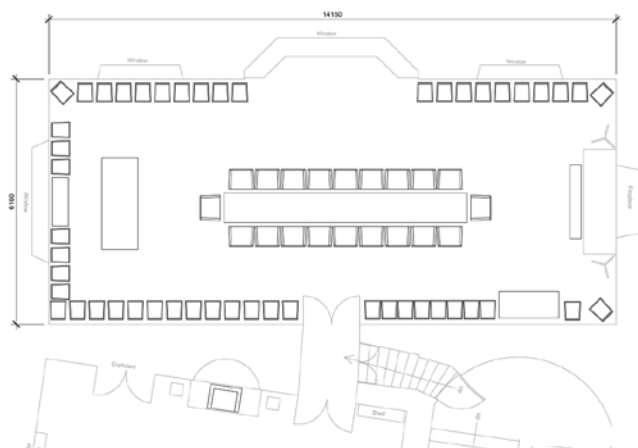


EXISTING FURNITURE & DIMENSIONS

Dimensions

14.1m x 6.1m

Due to the nature of the room, all furniture in the Alex Fitch Room must stay in position for any event. The room itself includes panelling from the Elizabethan period with the fireplace dating from the reign of Henry V. The floor is made of decking from H.M.S. Vincent, which served during the reign of George III. The furniture to the exterior of the room is from the reign of James I, as is the main dining table.

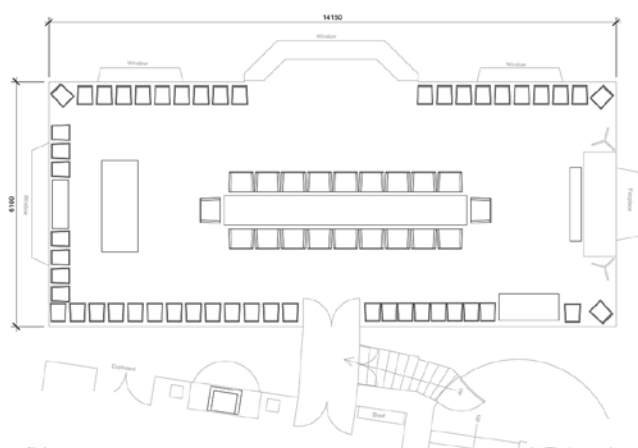
