The Harrow Explorer

The Harrow Explorer Package offers delegates a chance to explore their surroundings in a unique way. Wild Goose offer a GPS challenge allowing guests the unique opportunity to explore the beautiful grounds of Harrow School with a fun, interesting and competitive element using technology. The Hotspots are activated by using the GPS location of the team's iPad, meaning that the teams have to go and explore the grounds rather than simply sitting in a bar to answer the questions.

The content of the game can be completely bespoke the teams can answer multiple choice questions, free type questions, photo challenges or video challenges. The General knowledge questions can be a mixture of topics the clients are interested in from Sport to Whiskey. We can also introduce other activities into the GPS Challenge for instance Whiskey Tasting.

There is live scoreboard and activity feed during the game, this really helps to drive the competitive element of the challenge, we will turn this off 30 minutes before the end of the game to help maintain the element of suspense.

At the end of the challenge the event manager will showcase the best photos and videos from the event and present each member of the winning team with a gold medal.
